To better meet the needs of the changing population of persons experiencing homelessness within our community, adjustments were necessary. This project was a Safe Haven project type and could not be changed as a result. The funding recipient recognized it was in the best interest of the CoC and persons experiencing homelessness to reallocate funding to a new project designed specifically for persons living with SUD, SMI, or cooccurring disorders. The project applicant initiated reallocation and was notified via email on 9-1-23 that the CoC accepted the proposal to reallocate.

4-2. Describe how the CoC determined that this project should be reduced and include the date the project applicant was notified of the reduction. (limit 750 characters)

The project applicant notified the CoC's governing body that they would like to reallocate a portion of this project, due to underutilization. A primary factor in underutilization is a lack of supportive services and increased barriers to housing retention for person who are higher acuity. The CoC determined that time spent in transitional housing could be beneficial to persons with severe service needs. This determination was based on success seen while operating a non-congregate isolation and quarantine shelter that at times functioned similarly to transitional housing. The project applicant was notified via email that the CoC accepted their suggestion for reallocation on 9-1-23.
